Our Mission Statement

“To prevent and reduce bullying through evidence-based education, advocacy, and support for communities.”

Action Awareness is a national charity, and we want to positively change the lives of individuals by providing specialist support and guidance. To encourage people to come forward and get the relevant help they need.

Action Awareness provides confidential support and advice to those who experience bullying and suicidal thoughts regardless of their race, religion, gender, sexual orientation as the charity aims to work with people across the spectrum.

Advocating for Compassion, Understanding, and Support

Action Awareness is a non-profit organisation. Our main goal is to prevent suicide from happening to anyone by encouraging people to open their minds to differing viewpoints and ways of life.

Our way of accomplishing this is two-fold:

- By providing education in appreciating our unique differences as a way to prevent bullying**

Action Awareness focuses on promoting understanding and respect for people's differences, such as cultural, personal, or social traits by educating individuals, especially young people, about the value of diversity.

- Having resources available to the victims so they have a place to turn for support.**

We provide resources for individuals who are struggling with the emotional and mental effects of bullying or suicidal thoughts.

Our Projects

Suicide Prevention

Here at Action Awareness, we are firmly dedicated to the prevention of suicide and bullying through targeted education and awareness. We believe a key way to build resilience is by providing compassionate support and development for individuals who have suffered from, or may be vulnerable to, the impact of these issues. Our core mission is to empower people with the strength and understanding they need to navigate difficult times. To facilitate this, we offer a range of vital support services. These include direct education on suicide and bullying, workshops to develop mental health awareness, and clearly written information guides and booklets. We also provide confidential referrals to other support services and operate a 24/7 emergency helpline for individuals in crisis. In all our work, we aim to create a sense of community and belonging by providing safe, non-judgmental spaces for service users to engage with us.

Training

Our projects and training programmes provide engagement within the community for individuals and groups. We provide these courses to local councils, Healthcare professionals, schools, business, trade unions and those alike. Here at Action Awareness East Midlands, we are dedicated to empowering our community through targeted training and development. Our courses are carefully designed to support and strengthen individual skills, building the confidence that makes our service users more resilient, informed, and capable. Our current provision includes training on essential topics like Bullying Awareness, Suicide Awareness, Well-Being Champion, ICT skills, Customer Service, English, and Maths. We are excited about the future and are already planning to expand our offerings to provide even greater support.

Our Projects

Learning Bus

In an exciting new partnership, Action Awareness East Midlands is proud to be working with Stagecoach UK to launch an innovative mobile learning bus. This project transforms a vehicle into a dedicated learning hub on wheels, specifically designed to be deployed across the county. Our mission with this initiative is to break down geographical barriers, ensuring we can deliver vital learning provisions and support directly to even the most remote communities in Lincolnshire. Ultimately, the bus will serve as a dynamic and flexible classroom, ensuring that no one is left behind due to their location.

Jobs & Careers Fare(s)

We are excited to announce that we will be hosting a series of Jobs and Careers Fairs at various locations across Lincolnshire throughout 2025 and 2026. These events are a key part of our commitment to fostering employment and development opportunities, connecting local talent with leading organisations in the region. They allow individuals to connect directly with a wide range of employers empowering them to confidently take the next step in their professional journey.

Lift Assistance Scheme

Transport can be a significant barrier to health and well-being we are currently developing a new Lift Assistance Scheme. This initiative will operate as a voluntary car service, run by trusted volunteers. Providing reliable transport for a range of crucial journeys. Our drivers will help service users get to appointments with GPs, dentists, and other healthcare providers, as well as attend hospital visits and collect prescriptions. Furthermore, the service will ensure that travel is not a hurdle for those wishing to participate in our learning events, promoting easier access to all of our community programmes.
